





END OF YEAR PARENT SURVEY
JULY 2024


Parents were invited to share their views through a survey available at the end of the academic year using a Google Form. This was shared through a link in the newsletter and email correspondence. 121 responses were received.


















I am pleased with the home/school relationship

Extra curricular activities.

We would like to make the following suggestions:

Modernise the school uniform.

Continued improvement in communication with parents regarding curriculum and child's progress throughout the year.

Less junk sweets at Christmas & Summer fairs and afterschool. More natural products.

Longer hours of school days.

I would politely suggest a return to drumming for future year 4 children.

Allowing the children to have their Yr6 hoody's earlier.

We love St Luke's and can't think of anything we would want to change.

The students to take part in more borough sports competitions.

More emphasis on other sports and not just football.

I think there could be more communication between teachers and parents. We have parents' evening but it is only twice a year and for 10 minutes. Would be good even if we could get some email updates on how they are doing in the lessons.

That clubs (internal and external) continue till the end of term.

To continue providing opportunities for the children across age groups to mix and work together as my child always enjoys these opportunities.

Keep up the great work. From our experience the school has been great and we appreciate and are totally grateful that our child got to spend a year at St Luke's. The only thing trivial suggestion would be for Friday lunch there could be more variety, fish fingers gets old quite quickly.

Just keep doing it the same way with the same love and passion to the children! Thank you!
